Contents: Monographic Allocations, FY93

I have completed a tentative allocation of our book budget for monographs, which will need adjusting as new information and new priorities are identified. In the meantime, the overall allocations are listed on the following pages.

We have yet to decide on a distribution of funds within the subject codes (i.e. app.plan/firm order/s.o.), so that the monthly acquisitions reports do not have subtotals. Please review the activity to date, and notify me of any plans you have which would allow a further breakdown of these figures. (Standing order expenditures will be handled by allocating funds from the ZZA account to the new departmental account on a quarterly basis. Don't worry about standing orders this year. Next year you can worry about it!)

I offer a comparison of the May 1992 "Monograph Encumbrance Report" as a way to put these latest allocations into perspective.

Other comments: 1) All areas except PS and GEN overspent the allocation. 2) Based on FY92, we will need about \$42,000 for standing orders. 3) For the first time, books ordered in previous fiscal year, which are received in new fiscal year, will be charged to the new fiscal year budget.
