Language

1. I spoke with Blair about the problem of equipment purchase. He suggests that in the phrase "shall also be available for acquiring equipment and supplies"--in the 9th line under "State Projects" on page 27 of the print--we add the word "essential" so that it reads as follows:

"Such assistance shall also be available for acquiring essential equipment and supplies."

2. Could we please change the name throughout to Bicentennial Photography and Film Project (instead of "photographic," which I don't like and apparently neither do photographers).
