On May 18, 1967 the Faculty Senate voted to approve the following statement on the implementation of salary policy presently in effect:

Implementation

As indicated in footnote No. 1 paragraph 5.1 of the University Manual, actual compensation at U.R.I. shall be compared annually "with comparable data from approximately ten similar institutions in the Northeast". These are the state Universities of Connecticut, Delaware, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Vermont, and Rhode Island. It shall be our policy to keep average salaries by rank (for both academic and calendar year appointies) at the University of Rhode Island at least equal to the weighted average salaries of these ten institutions for comparable ranks.
