That the Faculty Senate approve the following statement for inclusion in the Faculty Manual (paragraph 6.9, page 53, 8th ed.).

6.9 Family Relationship. Family relationship shall not be a bar to appointment, except that two persons of the same family may not hold positions in which one of them is directly responsible for making recommendations regarding promotion, tenure, or salary of the other. Family is defined as spouse, children and their spouses, and siblings and their spouses and children.
