UNIVERSITY CALENDAR FOR 1997-1998

The Academic Standards and Calendar Committee is recommending a University Calendar for 1997-98 which is compatible with the calendar approved for 1996-97. Consistent with the Faculty Senate's action on December 7, 1995, the Academic Standards and Calendar Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate suspend the necessary provisions of the UNIVERSITY MANUAL (8.70.21, 8.70.22 and 8.70.23) and adopt the proposed 1997-1998 University Calendar:
