National Activities total under the conference agreement is derived by deducting separate authorizations for research, evaluation, demos, LMI, and literacy from total appropriations and then taking 10% of the reduced total.

Although most of National Activities money goes to local areas, either to the states or to Indian and Migrant organizations, it is shown separately because the eventual use of the money is uncertain.
