Both Senate and House bills contain ~~general~~ provisions requiring rotation of membership, broad public representation, proper reporting procedures and public access to information.

House bill requires committees to include 2 governor-appointed members

Name

State makes the basic designation of its appr. Hum. agency among above options. Note - it may choose exist. Comm. <sup>under m 2 optional</sup> <sub>= at 1st round</sub>

House makes state programs entities eligible for Amch. of Chm. Chairs - and places 2 gov. appointed members on committees.

State addresses 50% memb. on committees if it makes Fed. Fundam. 50% in first year; 100% thereafter.
