Issue: Minimum Allocation

Background: Both the House bill and the Senate amendment provide for minimum State allotments. The House bill proposes \$200,000 for each State, and the Senate bill proposes \$400,000 for each State.

In conference, we agreed to a minimum allotment amount of \$340,000, which is current law; however, the House is reluctant to go above \$300,000.

Talking Point: I believe that it is important not to go below the compromise minimum allotment amount of \$340,000, which maintains current law, so that no State will lose money.
