Arts and Humanities: Program Funding (1976): Report 03

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State Humanities Program (Modified)

The concept here is to

- a. permit existing State agencies which combine the Arts and the Humanities (11 states) to continue while encouraging eventual separate programs for the Arts on the one hand, and the Humanities on the other in those States... These could be called "existing State agencies" but it should be specified that they have this designation because they are so recognized by their State governments. These combined agencies should receive a minimum of \$100,000 each from the Endowment for support of the Humanities as applicable to Section 7 (c)... i.e. broad support of the program... present State Humanities committees have a limited program prescribed by State "themes" which focus in a given year on certain aspects of the Humanities, but do not in a given year include all areas.

- b. permit the Chairman to continue existing Humanities committees, while phasing in (over a ~~max~~ three-year span) new requirements which will make these committees responsive to State governments, and eventually similar to State Arts agencies. (see attached list)
