Amendment intended to be proposed by Mr. Domenici (for himself, Mr. Melcher, and Mr. Andrews)

Viz:

1 On page 8, beginning with line 25, strike out all through
2 line 14 on page 9 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

3 Sec. 14. (a) (1) To the extent of the availability of
4 funds for such purpose, the Secretary of the Interior ~~is~~ shall:
5 ~~authorized xxx~~

6 (A) enter into a thirty-year agreement with the
7 College of Santa Fe, Santa Fe, New Mexico, to provide
8 educational facilities for the use of, and to develop
9 cooperative educational/arts programs to be carried out
10 with the postsecondary fine arts and museum services
11 programs of, the Institute of American Indian Arts
12 administered by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

13 (B) conduct such activities as are necessary to
14 improve the facilities used by the Institute of American
15 Indian Arts at the College of Santa Fe.

16 (2) The provisions of this subsection shall take effect
17 on October 1, 1984.

18 (b) (1) The Secretary of the Interior, acting through the
19 Bureau of Indian Affairs, is directed to conduct a study for
20 the purpose of determining the need, if any, for a museum
21 facility to be established ~~on the grounds of the College of~~

1 ~~XXXXXX~~ for the benefit of the Institute of American Indian
2 Arts, the feasibility of establishing such museum, and the
3 need or desirability, if any, to establish any such museum in
4 close proximity to the facilities currently being used by
5 such Institute at the College of Santa Fe.

6 (2) On or before February 1, 1985, the Secretary of the
7 Interior shall report the results of such study, together
8 with his recommendations, to the Congress.

9 (3) Should the study recommend establishment of a museum,
10 and should the College of Santa Fe be selected as the best
11 site, any agreement entered into by the Secretary of the
12 Interior for construction of such museum shall contain
13 assurances, satisfactory to the Secretary, that appropriate
14 lands at the College of Santa Fe will be available at no cost
15 to the Federal Government for the establishment of a museum
16 facility.
