

Dear Senator Pell:

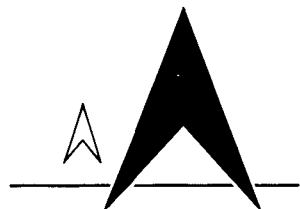
I am pleased to advise you that I plan to attend the scheduled hearings on the Museum Services Act, July 18 and 19, 1973, in Washington, D.C.
