**Note 102 (relating to funding for adult education activities)**

At the end of the staff recommendation, insert the following:

"The Senate recedes with an amendment as follows."

"SPECIAL RULE. --

( ) with respect to adult education activities, the State shall ensure the expenditure for adult education and literacy of an amount at least equal to the amount the State received under section 313 of the Adult Education Act for adult education activities in FY 1995. For any fiscal year in which funding for adult and literacy activities under section \_\_\_\_ is less than the amount received by the State in FY 1995, the state shall use sufficient funds under the flex account under section \_\_\_\_\_ to satisfy the requirements of this provision.
