## PRISON LITERACY

### Motion by Mr. Pell

*Mr. Pell moves that the conference recommendations be modified as follows:*

**Note 219** (relating to the allocation of workforce education funds)

"The House recedes with an amendment as follows."

"(A) Secondary school vocational education, or postsecondary and adult vocational education, or both; and

(B) 1 or more State corrections agencies to administer vocational education programs for juvenile and adult criminal offenders in correctional institutions in the State, including correctional institutions operated by local authorities."

**Note 227** (relating to the distribution of adult vocational funds)

"The House recedes with an amendment as follows."

"Strike (A) on line 35."

**Note 233** (relating to reservation of funds for corrections agencies)

"The Senate recedes."
