----- Message Contents -----

I want to make clear that the previous e-mail was a reflection of Ted's take on the current status of the process. He is reflecting his Chair's perception that this process is moving ahead and will be passed out of the conference one way or another.

My take remains the same as it has been all along. Together we are looking at offering a package of Dem amendments which represents the President's core issues and requirements. I do not expect the GOP to agree to these. There will be other issues outside of these core issues which we will offer amendments on as well.

Unless there is a dramatic shift in the legislation where these core issues are addressed I anticipate Sen. Kennedy's opposition to this legislation in the conference and on the floor of the Senate.

I hope this is a clear enough assessment of the situation.

I have a rough draft of a Democratic Letter that we may be asking conferees to sign and send to the Chairs of the two Committees. I will be circulating this latter today for your comments and assessment of your members ability to sign it.
