Language

1. I spoke with Blair about the problem of equipment purchase. He suggests that in the phrase "shall also be available for acquiring equipment and supplies"—in the 9th line under "State Projects" on page 27 of the print—we add the word "essential" so that it reads as follows:

"Such assistance shall also be available for acquiring essential equipment and supplies."

2. Could we please change the name throughout to Bicentennial Photography and Film Project (instead of "photographic," which I don't like and apparently neither do photographers).
