ARTS AND HUMANITIES

Funds for each state are not available until fiscal 67, (July 66) but funds for individual projects (such as repertory theater are available now. State funds should be applied for. now.

Preliminary conversations with the Office of Education indicate that they are prepared to spend up to 250,000 under title III for repertory theater. Plans of Foundation can not be known until after mid-November meeting of Arts Council. Not costed out yet anywhere, but probably OE funds under Title III could be spent for bussin, maintenance of facilities, provision of facilities and some salaries. Still flexible. Will not begin until the fall (program,) although funds under Humanities are presently available.
