Figure 1a. Cumulative totals of numbers of awards received FY11 through June FY15 YTD

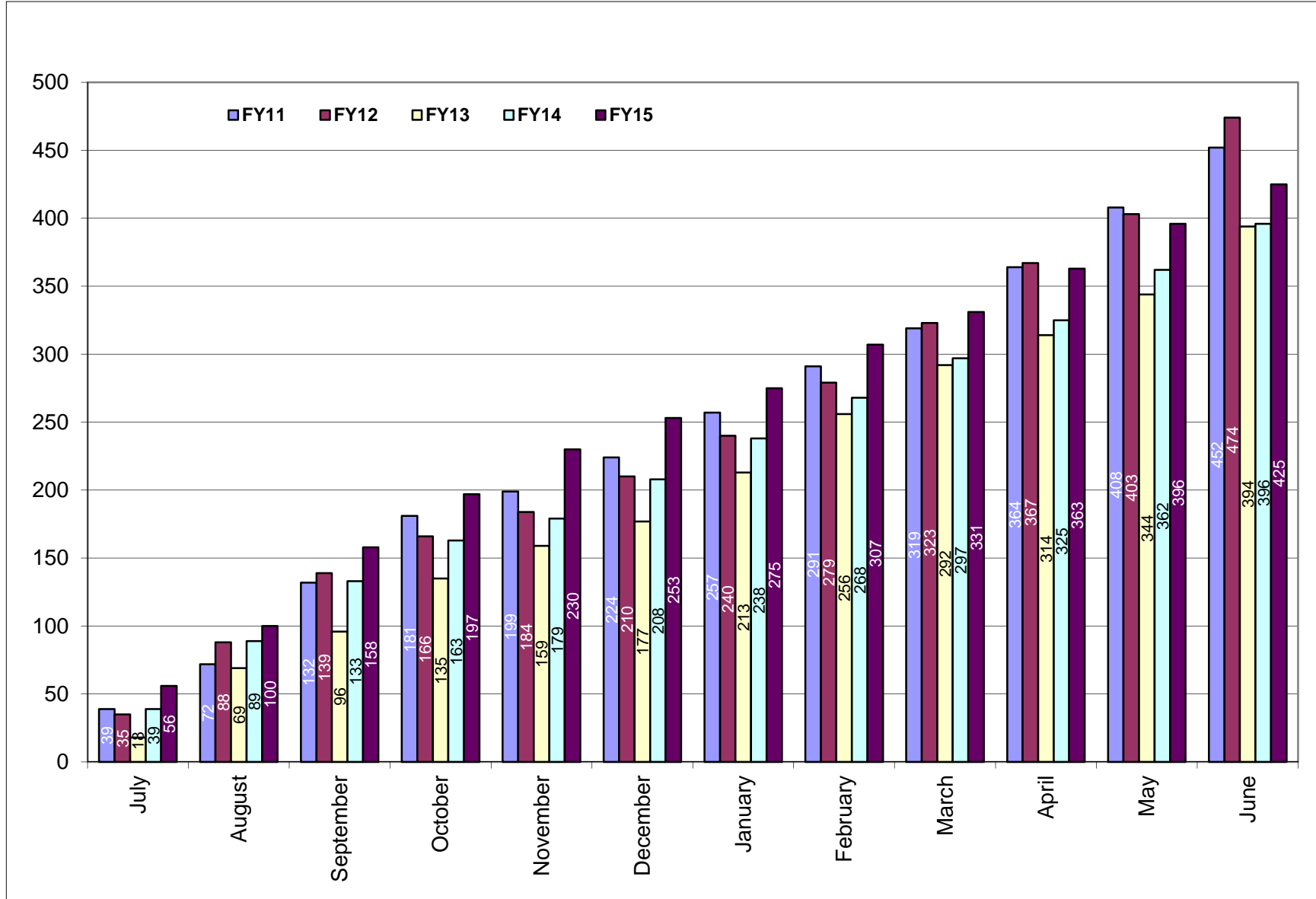


Figure 1b. Cumulative totals of award amounts received FY11 through June FY15 YTD

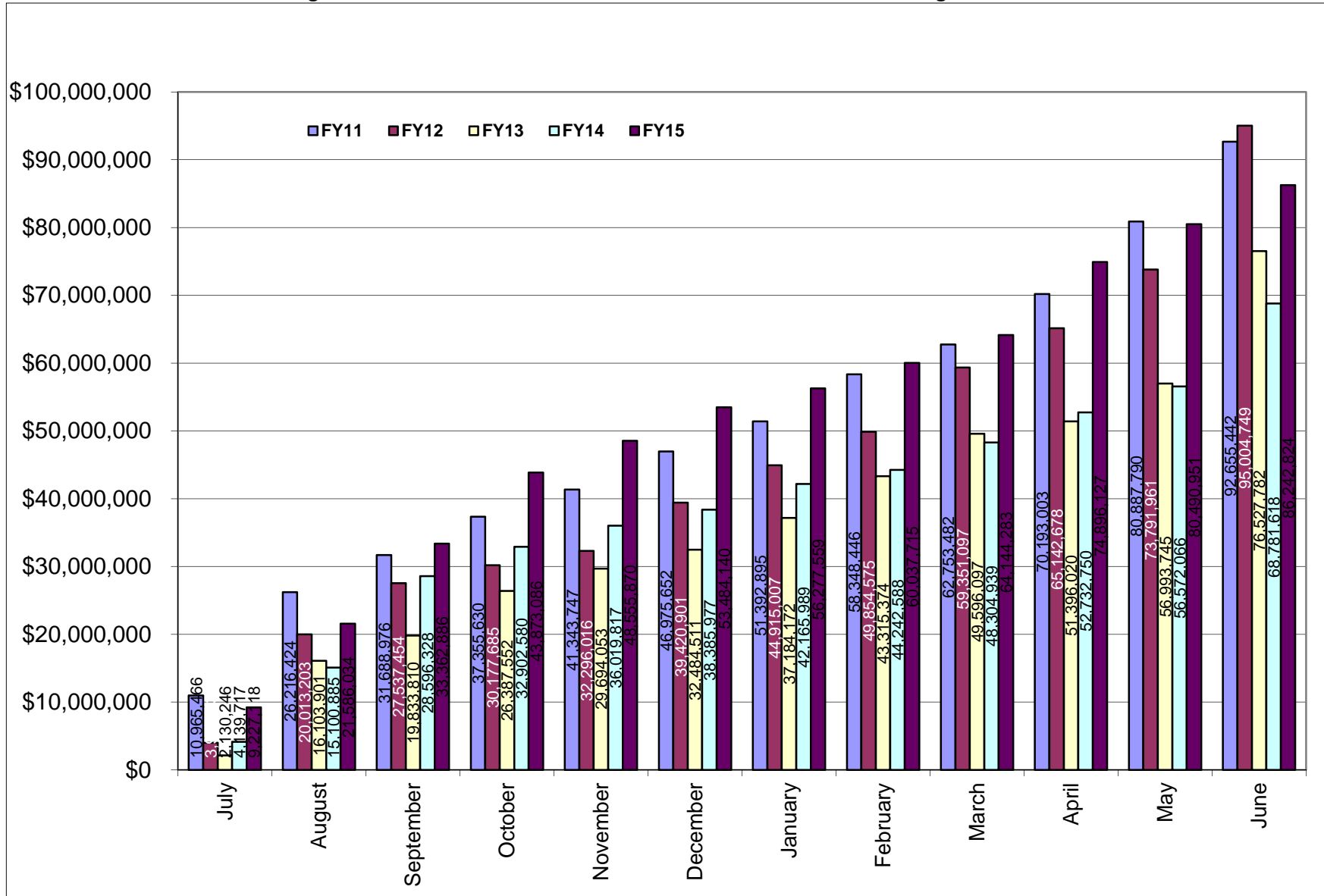
