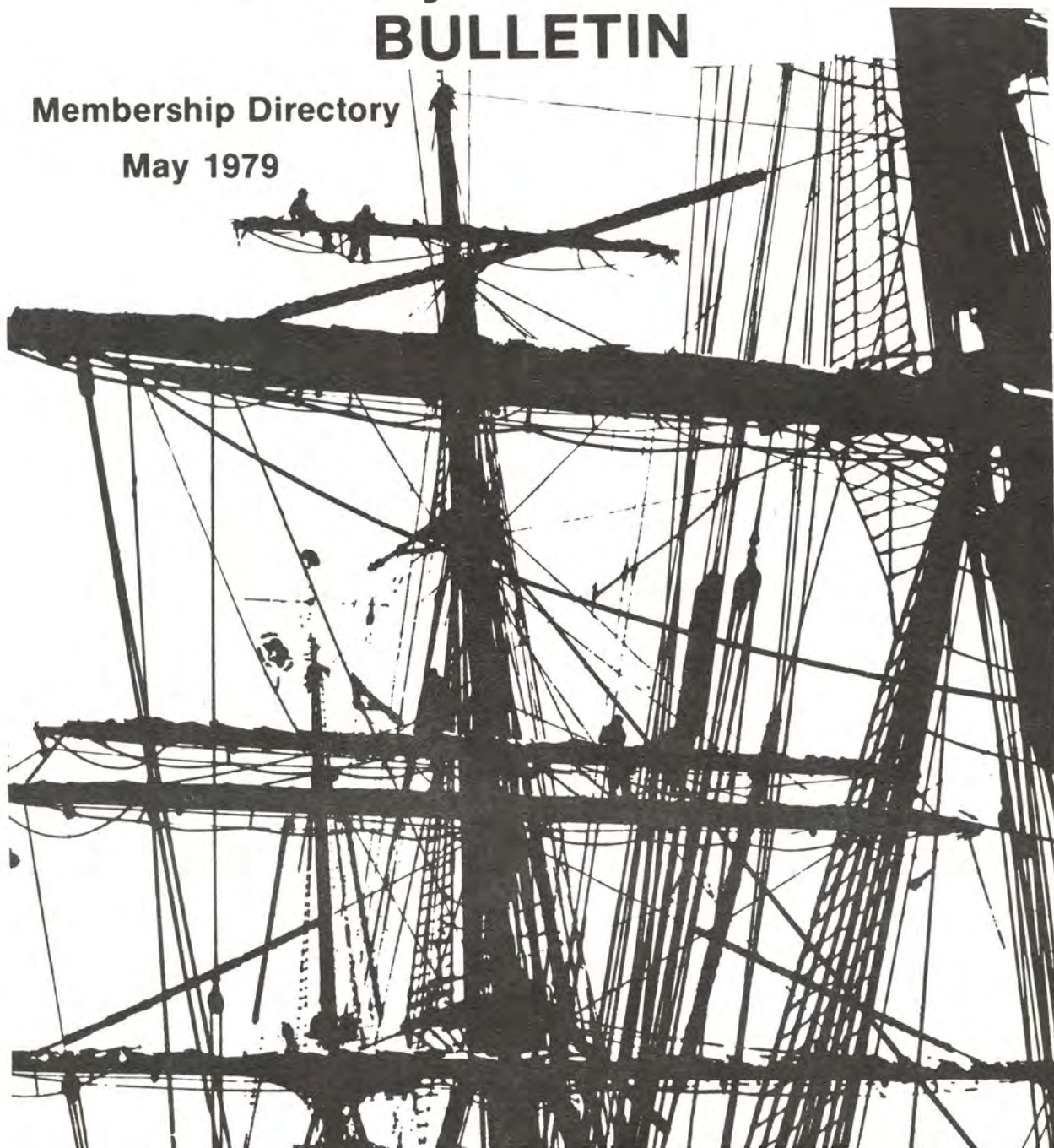

For the third time we offer you a RILA Membership Directory in the May issue of the RILA Bulletin. Thank you, Connie Lachowicz, Judith Einhorn, Betsey Kesler, Frank Notarianni, and Stewart Schneider, of the Membership Committee. The Committee reports a total membership of 542, including 510 individuals and 32 institutions. I notice this figure is down from last year's count of 565 members (526 individuals and 39 institutions) in spite of 79 new members this year. 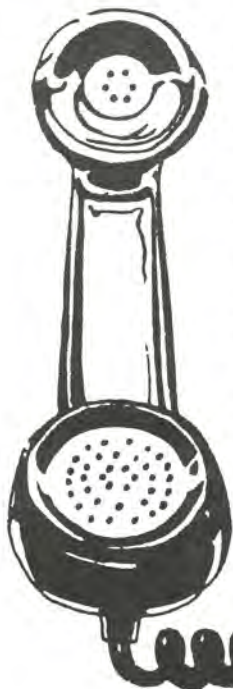

As I write, the news comes in on legislation for libraries with the closing day of the Rhode Island Legislative Session. All this year's library bills died in committee, but some of the content was incorporated into the Governor's budget. Providence Public Library receives \$160,000 and Pawtucket Public Library gets \$25,000 above the original 7% increase allotted for all state library funding.

I deplore the allocation of \$25,000 to the Pawtucket Public Library. This sort of special interest legislation undermines rational planning to spend state money for maximum benefit to the whole state. In some way the per capita basis for allocation of funds causes inequities - but it's better than no system at all. The Pawtucket legislation opens the door to a free-for-all for every public library to bid for its own funds. Will we see next year 39 different bills for special funding for libraries? Naturally the big jurisdictions will have clout to get what they want, and the small localities will get nothing. How can we work for fair allocation of funds to all parts of the state?

It is my impression that many librarians think of political activity, "That's not part of my job!" We're shy, we're worried what our bosses will think when we're not behind our desks, but talking to legislators at the State House, and we don't know exactly what to do. I am as bad about my civic responsibilities as anyone, so I am encouraging myself, as well as you, to take action.

The lesson from this year's legislative activity is that we must all become politically aware and politically active, in self-defense, or the support each region has will erode away.

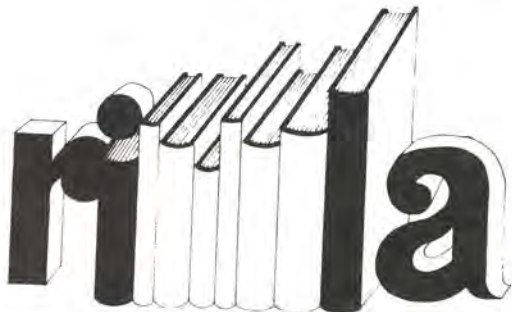

NEWS FROM RILA

Two representatives from the Rhode Island Library Association have been nominated by RILA and accepted by ALA to attend an ALA pre-conference on Anglo-American Cataloging Rules II. They are Marguerite Horn, Brown University, and Cecilia Dulik, University of Rhode Island Library. RILA is partially funding their attendance at \$150.00 each. When they return they will lead workshops for Rhode Island librarians on AACR II.

The Personnel Committee of RILA reports on a survey of public library salaries in Rhode Island. They compared salaries for public library directors and beginning professionals in selected cities and towns in Rhode Island and Massachusetts, matching for population size. The summary results are as follows:

Public Library Directors

median	\$13,058	\$16,670

Beginning Professionals

An appended list compares library directors' salaries for 44 Rhode Island and Massachusetts towns of similar size. In every case the Massachusetts salary is higher.

The Personnel Committee "recommends that the Department of State Library Services conduct a salary survey of the state's public libraries, with a view to publicizing the results and formulating salary standards to be promulgated and enforced in the state's public libraries."

GLS SECOND ANNUAL GATHERING

The Second Annual Gathering of the URI Graduate Library School was well attended by alumni, faculty and friends. Over 150 people convened at the Memorial Union for a day of stimulating and enjoyable activities.

Dr. Peggy Sullivan, candidate for President-elect of the American Library Association, spoke on "A Long Look at Lean Years Ahead." She feels all librarians should take a hard look at present funding levels and put them in proper perspective. Addressing the question of funding problems putting more limitations on imagination, she said no, in fact, we'll need to use our imagination to adapt present buildings, activities, and programs to new ideas. In the case of old buildings, some could be turned into multi-purpose areas, but a rush to convert empty school buildings for this purpose should be carefully studied in that they are quite often deteriorating or placed in poor locations.

Sullivan sees new legislation as one result of the White House Conference, centering on informational needs rather recreational programming. It would be wrong, however, to assume this will mean a decrease in children's activities such as story hours, films, etc. For children, these activities are information; it's a matter of expanding definitions.

Librarians, Dr. Sullivan stressed, are placing inappropriate emphasis on techniques and human relations rather than materials and resources. We should be aware of the materials available

in our libraries so patrons aren't unnecessarily referred elsewhere. . Technique is important in dealing with patron's questions but should be integrated with knowledge of resources.

In the area of personnel, there will be less room for librarians to move upward in their institutions. Without that advancement, ways to improve status while staying in the same position will be important to staff morale. Continuing education, professional activities, and writing are some of the ways mentioned to meet these needs.

The future may be a time of mistrust of public service workers in general. For librarians this will make it necessary to convince others they need what libraries have to provide. The State Governor's Conferences on Library and Information Services have started us in that direction by forcing us to form and coordinate ideas.

Acknowledging the future and understanding the fact that we may experience lean years ahead together as a profession, can provide some comfort. Following a short question and answer period, the group moved on to lunch and the announcement of the recipient of the 1979 GLS Alumni Award.

The recipient of this award was hardly a surprise. Dr. Bernard Schlessinger, Dean of the GLS, was presented a plaque recognizing him as this year's outstanding alumnus. The award was presented by Dr. Nancy Potter, Professor of English at URI, and Acting Dean of the GLS in 1976-77. (Dean Schlessinger received his MLS from URI in 1975.)

Discussion groups held after lunch were led by faculty and students. Talk centered on issues raised by Dr. Sullivan with specific examples from different types of libraries presented. Afterward Professor Salvatore, from the GLS faculty, presided over the initiation of new members to Beta Phi Mu at Rodman Hall. The ceremony was followed by wine, cheese, and conversation.

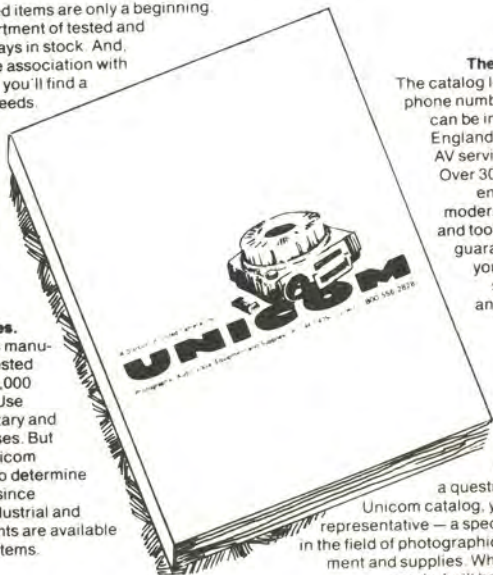
