1. CALL TO ORDER

The Faculty Senate Executive Committee (FSEC) meeting was called to order at 10:46 AM by Chair Nassersharif in the Library Room 203, with Vice Chair Echevarria (teleconferenced), Senators Morokoff and Barbour were in attendance. Senators Gindy and Hicks were absent.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

a. FSEC Meeting #9 August 6, 2019 approved as amended.

3. ANNOUNCEMENTS/CORRESPONDENCE/REPORTS

a. The Faculty Senate Executive Committee has been asked to submit names of two faculty members to serve on the Search Committee for a Chief Diversity Officer. After discussion, four individuals were proposed to serve on the Search Committee. Chair Nassersharif will forward their names to the Provost.

4. OLD BUSINESS

a. The Chair Nassersharif discussed his meeting with the President and the Provost on the final conclusions of the Special Joint Committee on Graduate School Governance. The Special Joint Committee will be asked to present their report to the Faculty Senate during the October meeting.
