**Faculty Senate Executive Committee (FSEC)
Meeting # 21 November 1, 2019 MINUTES**

1. CALL TO ORDER

- a. The Faculty Senate Executive Committee (FSEC) meeting was called to order at 10:47 AM in the President's Conference by Chair Nassersharif. Vice Chair Echevarria, Senators Morokoff, Barbour and Hicks were in attendance. Senator Gindy absent.

- a. The Faculty Senate Chair reported on his meeting with the Provost regarding re-establishing the Phi Kappa Phi honor society on campus.
