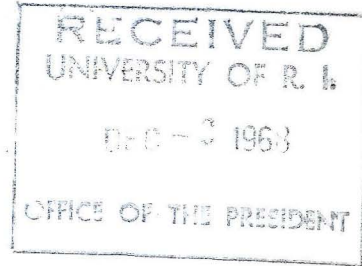

1. The Attached BILL, titled Administrative Appointment of Legal Officer to Advise University Personnel in Areas of Civil Rights
