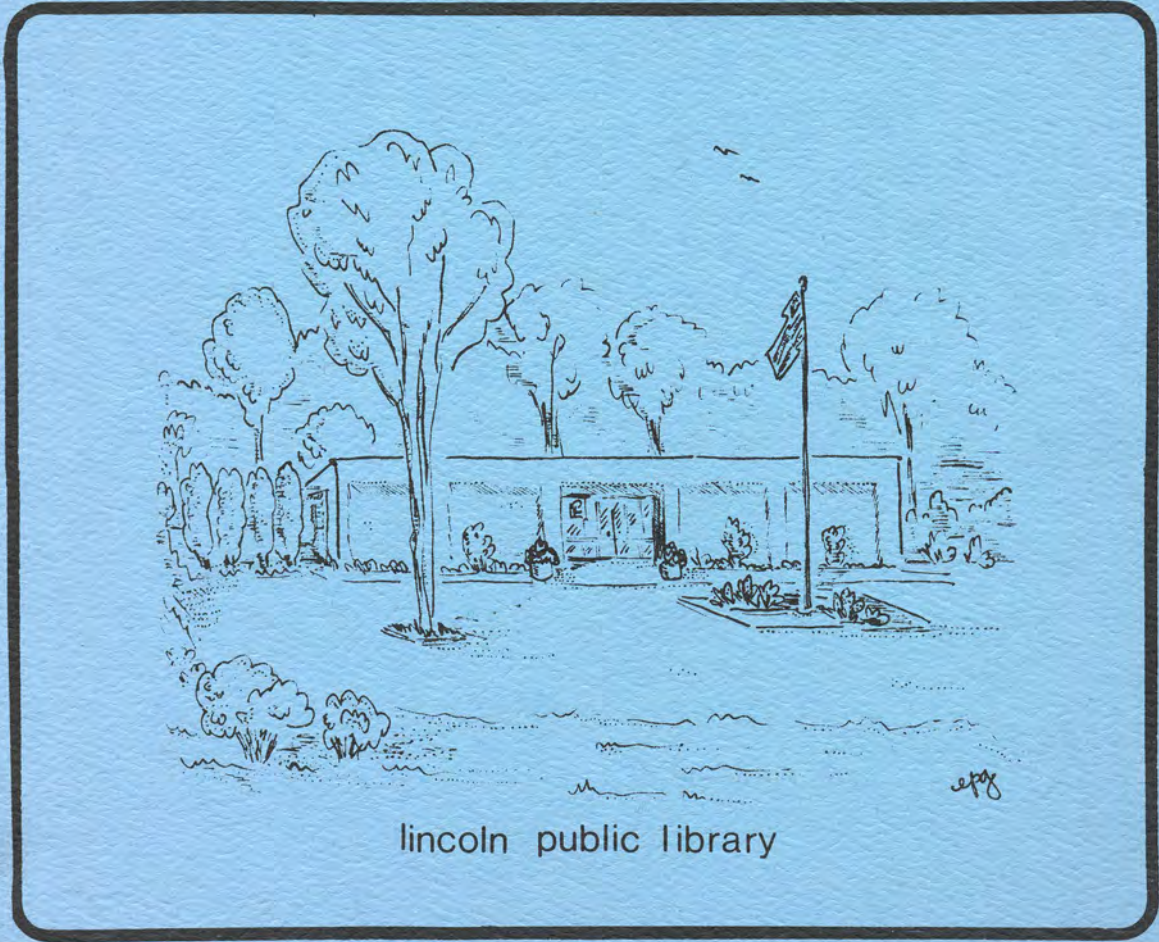

EDITORIAL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES



The Bulletin is a publication for public, school, academic, and special libraries in Rhode Island.

Published by the Rhode Island Library Association, it is open to news and articles of interest to RILA members. Articles contained therein, however, do not necessarily reflect the ideas of the RILA membership, Executive Board, Bulletin staff, or Bulletin advertisers. Controversy is welcomed as long as it stimulates communication and promises understanding.

The Bulletin editor reserves the right to reject any item submitted for publication, with the exception of items submitted by the Executive Board or by its president on behalf of the Board. Occasionally, the editor may question whether a particular item submitted by the Executive Board or by the RILA President is appropriate for Bulletin publication. In this case, the editor is empowered to discuss the item with the Board in order to achieve a suitable compromise or a better understanding of the appropriateness of the item. All items submitted to the Bulletin are subject to editorial revision, with the exception of official communications from the Executive Board.

Editorial comments in the Bulletin may dissent from RILA Executive Board opinion. The work of the Bulletin staff is subject to review at any time by the Board. Changes in frequency and format of the Bulletin must be approved by the Executive Board.

The Bulletin staff will consist of an editor-in-chief in charge of content, a production editor in charge of production, and a news editor in charge of news items. In addition, staff will consist of individuals responsible for circulation, advertising, job line, calendar, mailing, and other related duties. All staff report to the editor-in-chief.

Articles of more than two pages must be received by the editor-in-chief by the first of the month prior to the month of publication. News items, job, and calendar listings, and brief items of interest must be received by the editor or the appropriate staff persons by the fifteenth of the month prior to the month of publication.

Copies of writer's and guest editor's guidelines are available upon request from the editor-in-chief. All articles submitted must be signed and should not exceed ten typewritten pages, unless the editor is consulted.



WRITER'S GUIDELINES FOR THE
RILA BULLETIN

All manuscripts must be typewritten and double spaced.

Manuscripts should average between 5 to 10 pages. The editor must be consulted if a manuscript will run longer than 10 pages. Keep in mind that $1\frac{1}{2}$ double spaced pages will equal approximately one page of text in the Bulletin.

Whenever possible, charts, graphs, tables, etc. which accompany the article should be camera-ready (i.e. have clean, dark lines, be neatly drawn with no cross-outs, and be easily reducible without interfering with readability).

The editor will correct spelling, grammar and syntax and may occasionally rewrite a sentence or paragraph if necessary for the sake of clarity and readability. However, the writer will be contacted should the editor feel that the manuscript needs major revision. The writer may choose to withdraw the manuscript rather than to rewrite it according to the editor's specific recommendations.

If the article submitted is an interview or personal profile, the writer must obtain permission from the person being interviewed stating that the interview may be printed in the Bulletin.

All direct quotations or summaries of other writer's ideas must be footnoted. Footnotes and bibliographies should follow: Kate L. Turabian, A Manual for Writers of Term Papers, Theses, and Dissertations, 4th edition, (Chicago: University of Chicago Press, 1973).

All articles of more than 2 typewritten pages must be received by the first of the month for publication in the following month's Bulletin. Brief news items, committee reports, and reports of important meetings and conferences should be sent to the RILA Bulletin news editor.

If it is wished that a manuscript be returned, it must be accompanied by a stamped, self-addressed envelope.

GUEST EDITOR'S GUIDELINES FOR THE
RILA BULLETIN



Guest editors are responsible for soliciting articles from various contributors, ensuring that all articles are received on schedule, and editing articles before submitting them to the editor-in-chief for publication. All articles of more than 2 typewritten pages must be received by the editor-in-chief by the first of the month for publication in the following month.

Primarily, editing of manuscripts should be limited to correcting spelling, grammar, and syntax, eliminating unnecessary repetition and redundant words and phrases, combining short sentences, simplifying long, involved sentences, reparagraphing, etc., whenever doing so will improve the clarity and general readability of the article.

It is not the guest editor's responsibility to rewrite or substantially alter the sense or writing style of an article. Editorial courtesy demands that the writer be contacted if major changes need to be made in his/her manuscript; in which case, the writer may choose either to make the changes or to withdraw the manuscript. The editor should be contacted immediately if there are problems in editing an article.

The guest editor should send each writer a copy of the writer's guidelines (available from the editor-in-chief) with a brief letter confirming the date that the manuscript is due. It is a good idea to call a week before the deadline to make sure the writer has not run into difficulties in meeting the deadline.

The guest editor writes a brief introduction and overview of his/her issue which is published in the Bulletin as a "Guest Editor's Notebook". Although it is not required, guest editors may wish to supply cover art for their issues and may also wish to send out personally the complimentary issues due to the contributors.

RILA Personnel Committee: Preliminary Results
of the 1981 Salary Survey

This is the second year of the public library salary survey conducted jointly by the State Department of Library Services (DSLS), the Rhode Island Library Association (RILA), and the University of Rhode Island Graduate Library School (URI/GLS). Because of the intense interest generated by the first survey, the Personnel Committee decided to publish the summary charts as soon as the data became available.

Some changes have resulted from the last survey. The most important change is in the response rate. This year we have received 100% of the questionnaires that were sent out. DSLS has now included the salary questionnaire as part of the annual library report. But, it must also be pointed out that the spirit of compliance exhibited will result in an accurate picture of the financial state of the profession in Rhode Island. The committee thanks the public library directors and all those who contributed to the survey this year.

In the spring, a full report of the salary survey will be published in the Bulletin. As we did last year, we will provide you with a full analysis and commentary on the survey.

Shown below are eight tables which summarize the data collected in the 1981 survey along with data from the 1980 report. A few words of caution and clarification are necessary in order to avoid misinterpretation. First, the 100% response has altered many of the figures derived from the 1980 survey which did not achieve total response. As Table 1 shows, twelve additional libraries were included in the survey for 1981. Given the small number of libraries in the state, this represents a sizeable change in the salary ranges and other data. And in addition, some population changes have moved libraries from one category to another. Thus, the figures for 1981 are not directly comparable to the 1980 survey. The figures in parentheses () represent the Massachusetts Salary Survey as compared in the 1980 survey. The 1981 figures are not yet available but should be soon. They will be included in the full salary survey report this spring. Finally, it is strongly urged that you take a look at the 1980 Salary Survey (RILA Bulletin, April, 1981) to review how the figures in the tables were derived and the procedures used in compiling the data. This is extremely important in order to avoid misinterpretation.

The Personnel Committee hopes that you will find this data useful. If you have any questions or comments we would appreciate it if you would contact one of the authors of this report or a member of the committee. Since this survey is for your benefit, we feel that you should have the opportunity to advise the committee of your concerns.

This month, we are pleased to present the Association's Sixth Annual Membership Directory. Since the Membership Committee files provide the information for the directory, individuals are asked to check entries and report any changes to the Chair of the Membership Committee, Paul Drake (Warwick Public Library, 739-1919). Membership figures as of December 1, 1981 include 510 individual members and 31 institutional members. By type of library or affiliation, the membership can be divided into the following categories: 147 public; 107 academic; 66 trustee; 52 special; 45 school; 17 student; 37 retired; and 39 other (self-employed, unemployed, or no designation). Institutional memberships by type of library are: 20 public; 5 academic; and 6 special.
