Change in structure of Graduate Council (Section 5.1.5a University Manual)

a. <u>Membership</u>. The Graduate Council is composed of eighteen representatives of whom thirteen are faculty members, <u>four are graduate students</u>, and the eighteenth is the Dean of the Graduate School. . .

Graduate student members of the Graduate Council include the following: The President (or, at the discretion of the President, but not interchangeably, the Vice President) of the Graduate Student Association, serving for the academic year following his election or reelection; Two graduate students chosen by the Graduate Student Council to serve one-year terms, but eligible for one reelection; One graduate student chosen by the Dean of the Graduate School to serve a one-year term but eligible for one reappointment.
