Dear Walter:

I am temporarily holding Bill 69-70-11, calling for the inclusion of disability benefits for the faculty in the 1970-71 budget.

There is no doubt in my mind that the Board of Trustees will authorize an appropriate plan if it can be absorbed within the approved budget.

The key questions revolve around the cost which would be involved, which Vice President O'Connell is now seeking to establish, and the availability of funds. The latter would be a problem even if we were appropriated the full amount sought, and a serious problem if there is a cut from the requested amount.

I will keep the Executive Committee apprised of developments.
