8.55.13 Courses that are stipulated in the student's curriculum as degree requirements shall not be taken for S/U credit. The intellectual opportunity plan shall pertain only to those courses that are considered as free, unattached electives by the college in which the student is enrolled. In addition, any course above the credits required for graduation may be taken as S/U. A college may, however, by a vote of its faculty, permit other courses to come under this plan for students enrolled in that college. This vote must be confirmed by the Senate through the Curricular Affairs Committee.
