Add the phrase, "except for those courses officially designated as S/U courses in Section 8.10.14 on page 53" to the end of the first sentence of Section 8.55.13 on page 72. The Section would then read:

8.55.13 Courses that are stipulated in the student's curriculum as degree requirements shall not be taken for S/U credit, except for those courses officially designated as S/U courses in Section 8.10.14 on page 53. The intellectual opportunity plan shall pertain only to those courses that are considered as free, unattached electives by the College in which the student is enrolled. In addition, any course above the credits required for graduation may be taken as S/U. A college may, however, by a vote of its faculty, permit other courses to come under this plan for students enrolled in that college. This vote must be confirmed by the Senate through the Curricular Affairs Committee.
