- A. Vote on recommendations of Constitution and By-Laws Committee to change By-Laws of Senate as follows:
 - 1. Modify Section 5 Paragraph 4 (Faculty Manual, 9th Edition, page 93) to read as follows:
 - 5.4 Should a vacancy occur in the Executive Committee two months or more before the annual election, it shall be filled at the next regular Senate meeting by an election held in the same manner as the regular election of officers, except that the Executive Committee shall act as nominating committee.
 - 2. Add a new paragraph 5.5, as follows:
 - 5.5 Should a vacancy occur in the vice chairmanship, the Executive Committee shall name an eligible member of its body to perform the vice chairman's duties for the remainder of the unexpired term. The ensuing vacancy in the Executive Committee shall then be filled according to the provisions of Section 5.4.
 - 3. Add a new paragraph 5.6, as follows:
 - 5.6 Should a vacancy occur in the chairmanship, the vice chairman shall succeed to that position for the remainder of the unexpired term, and the Executive Committee shall name an eligible member of its body to perform the vice chairman's duties for the same period. The ensuing vacancy in the Executive Committee shall then be filled according to the provisions of Section 5.4.
