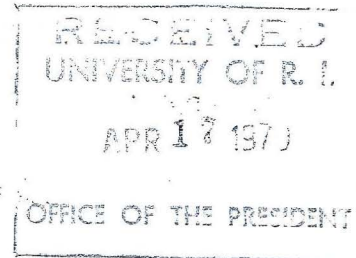

If the bill is forwarded to the Board of Trustees, it will not become effective until approved by the Board.

The Senate requests the President to establish a standing University Committee for Improvement of the Campus Environment with the following charge:

The purpose of this committee is to make a continuing study of the campus environment; to determine the causes of pollution on campus and the effects of the University on the local environment; to develop programs for eliminating and controlling the causes of pollution on campus; and to consider means for restoring, retaining, and maintaining the physical beauty of the campus.

The committee shall maintain liaison with local governments, with non-University groups, and with academic and non-academic groups on campus that are concerned with the quality of the environment.

The committee shall make its recommendations to the President or the Vice President for Business Affairs, as appropriate.

The committee shall make an annual report of its findings and recommendations to the University community.

The committee shall consist of four faculty members, four student members, and the Director of the Physical Plant, ex-officio.
