The Senate requests that the President activate the University Committee on Police and Public Safety: a) to include representatives of the faculty and student bodies on the Committee b) and to charge the Committee: 1) to study the current situation concerning civil disorder and law enforcement on the URI campus; 2) to determine adequate procedures for insuring civil order and public safety on the campus; 3) to make appropriate recommendations to the President; 4) to make a report of its findings and recommendations to the University community.
