Credit for "Auditing" of courses.

An auditor may be admitted to a class with consent of the instructor and with a card of admission from the Registrar. An auditor may take part in any exercises of the class such as recitations, discussions or tests with the consent of the instructor. He may, by making an agreement satisfactory to the instructor as to presenting evidence for completing the course by faithful attendance have the symbol AUD (carrying no credits or quality points) reported as a grade to the Registrar and have this appear upon his record. In the absence of the above agreement no report is made to the Registrar and the audited course will not show on the student's record.
