Senate Bill #71-72-11 Fiscal Priorities Amendment

Proposed amendment to Section 5.77.10 Addition Underlined

5.77.10 The Educational Policy Committee.

The purpose of this committee shall be to advise the President and the Faculty Senate. Its reports and recommendations may be addressed to either, but shall be made available to both. The committee shall study and make recommendations to the President and/or the Faculty Senate regarding matters of general policies affecting the University at large; such as: interpretation of the mission of the University, within the general outlines laid down by state law and the Board of Regents, and its relation to needs of the state, the nation and society; needs for expansion, undergraduate and graduate; and relationship of the University with secondary schools, proposed community colleges, junior colleges and technical institutes. It shall be the responsibility of this committee to conduct an annual fiscal review of all programs, existing and newly approved, and to recommend to the Faculty Senate and President, fiscal priorities for all programs.
