INTERIM REPORT - FACULTY SENATE HONORS PROGRAM COMMITTEE

1. Program funding has been reviewed. The Committee recommends that program funding for 1972-73 fiscal year be maintained at the same level as for fiscal 1971-72. By 'program funding' we mean basic operating budget plus salaries for assistants. Honors Colloquium Coordinator's salary depends on base salary but is to be computed on the same basis as for fiscal 1971-72.

Details are as follows:

Basic Operating Budget 1971-72 (Budget Account 229-02)	\$ 11,480
Salaries for Assistants 1971-72 (Budget Account 229-01)	\$ 7,833

Sub-total	\$ 19,313

Plus 16% of previous year's salary to Coordinator  
for preparations during Summer Session.

Plus 50% of Coordinator's 9 month salary to home  
department for replacement.

2. The Committee is continuing work on the following items:
  - a. Discussion of possibility of recommending merger of Honors Program and Visiting Scholars Committees. Professor Stephen B. Wood, Chairman of the Visiting Scholars Committee is an invited guest to these discussions.

- c. Review of procedures for departmental participation in Honors Program.
- d. Review of point/hour ratio requirements for Honors Program.
- e. Preparation of Honors Program Folder for 1972-73 and review of URI Catalog material.
- f. Continuing discussion of aims and philosophy of the Honors Program.
- g. Other current and future problems.
