**Recommendation 2.** The Calendar Committee requests the approval of the following guidelines for reference to future Calendar Committees:

- a. Registration for the fall semester will begin the Tuesday after Labor Day in all subsequent years.
- b. Holidays are to be retained in the calendar.
- c. The calendar should be so established as to provide 44 class meetings (MWF) or the equivalent each semester.

**Recommendation 3.** The Calendar Committee requests deletion of the six (6) week term from the Summer Session Calendar.
