Informational Report to the Faculty Senate

April 20, 1977

In response to a request from Professor Daniel Bergen, Chairperson of the Faculty Senate, the Constitution, By-Laws and University Manual Committee reviewed the wording of section 4.11.10 of the University Manual. The CBUM Committee agreed that the wording of section 4.11.10 does not quite coincide with the clear intention of the University Manual (as proven for instance by University Manual 7.10.10) to grant full faculty status to Librarians.

The CBUM Committee proposes the following editorial change to the wording of the first sentence of section 4.11.10 to read as follows (changes are underlined):

4.11.10 Membership in the University Faculty, also referred to as the General Faculty, shall be based on appointment by the President and on direct participation in or supervision of <u>any of the following activities</u>: teaching, <u>librarianship</u>, research, within the University or its Extension divisions.

The present first septence of 4.11.10 reads:

4.11.10 Membership in the University Faculty, also referred to as the General Faculty, shall be based on appointment by the President and on direct participation in or supervision of teaching, librarianship, and research within the University or its Extension divisions.
