1. The attached BILL, titled Recommendation of the Minorities and Special Groups Committee Regarding Publicity for Services available for Minorities and Special Groups, is forwarded for your consideration.

If the bill is forwarded to the Board of Regents, it will not become effective until approved by the Board.
