FACULTY SENATE

On January 23, 1975, the Faculty Senate approved the following amendment to section 4.50.12 of the <u>University Manual</u> as proposed by the Constitution, By-Laws and University Manual Committee at the request of the College of Arts and Sciences:

4.50.12 Attendance at meetings of a college faculty is expected. One-half (15% of colleges with more than 200 members) of the membership shall constitute a quorum.
