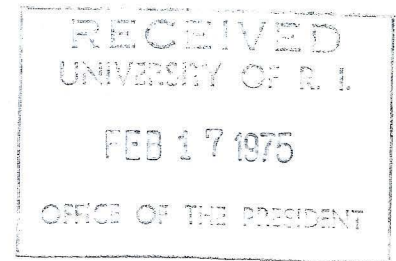

HONORS PROGRAM AND VISITING SCHOLARS COMMITTEE

February 4, 1975

The Honors Program and Visiting Scholars Committee recommends to the Faculty Senate that the quality point average for eligibility for Honors Work be changed from "3.0" to "3.3."

The Committee proposes that section 8.51.10 be amended as follows:

(Changes are underlined)

8.51.10 Eligibility. Within two weeks after computing fall semester grades, the Registrar shall notify every sophomore and junior with a cumulative average of at least 3.3 of his or her quality point eligibility for honors work. The Registrar shall send a copy of the notice to the student's academic dean and adviser.
