EGR 124X Working with Metals

Introduction to the shaping and treating of metals and alloys; effects of metallic grain size, strain, and temperature on mechanical properties; hot vs. cold forming, machining, soldering, brazing, and welding. Prerequisite: High school physics and chemistry. Mohrnheim
