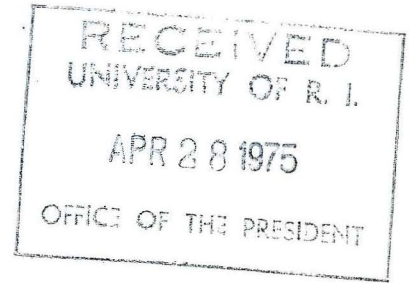

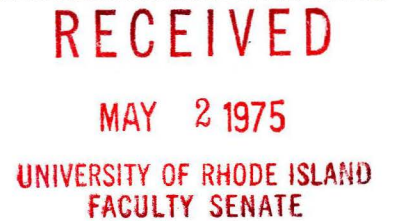

On April 24, 1975, the Faculty Senate approved the following recommendations of the Executive Committee:

- 1) That the action taken by the Faculty Senate at its meeting of March 20, 1975 on student evaluation of teaching be deferred until Fall, 1975.
- 2) That the teaching evaluation forms be made available to all faculty who wish to administer and score their own forms during the Spring 1975 Semester.

In addition, the Faculty Senate approved the following motion:

- 3) That the Vice President for Academic Affairs be requested to collect a volunteer sample of approximately 2,000 evaluations representing different kinds of courses for computer analysis.
