UNIVERSITY OF RHODE ISLAND Kingston, Rhode Island

On May 8, 1975 the Faculty Senate approved the following amendment to the <u>University Manual</u>:

Change is underlined.

8.12.10 Reporting of Records. All grades shall be reported to the Registrar on the prescribed form not later than 48 hours after the end of the final examination period, with the provision that an extension of time may be allowed in individual cases by approval of the dean of the college on written request of the instructor. All instructors shall submit grades not later than 96 hours after the end of the final examination in the course concerned, except that the time limits shall be 72 hours when the examination is given on the next to the last day of the examination period and 48 hours when the examination is given on the last day. If the final examination period ends within 48 hours of December 25, then the deadline for submitting grades will be extended to 48 hours (2 working days) after December 25.
