The Faculty Senate approved:

DELETION: COMMITTEE ON HIGHER EDUCATION FOR DISADVANTAGED STUDENTS

from a standing committee of the Faculty Senate, (Section 5.81.10) of the <u>University Manual</u>, and changed it to a:

SPECIAL COMMITTEE

which would cease to exist, as such, upon submission of its final report.

The charge to the special committee is as follows:

- to define who are disadvantaged students that the University should seek to assist
- to recommend the specific program⁵ the University should develop to assist these disadvantaged students
- to recommend priorities among these programs in terms of the allocation of institutional resources.
