FACULTY SENATE

On May 16, 1974 the Faculty Senate approved the following amendment to Section 7.2 of the By-Laws:

7.2 Senate Meetings shall begin at 3:00 p.m. and shall be limited to two hours in length. Debate on each main motion and each amendment thereto shall be limited to fifteen minutes. Debate may be extended in any Senate meeting by a one-third vote of the members present.
