FACULTY SENATE

On May 16, 1974, the Faculty Senate approved the following three Recommendations of the Special Committee to Evaluate Administrators:

1. During the 1974-75 academic year, there shall be a faculty evaluation of administrative officers and department chairpersons of the University, as provided for below. Its purpose shall be to evaluate the efficiency and effectiveness of administrators with a view to constructive criticism and to provide guidance for self-improvement.
2. All full-time teaching and research faculty, including extension faculty, librarians and department chairpersons shall have the opportunity to participate in the evaluation.
