Proposal No. 1

GRADES INVOLVED IN FAILURE TO DROP A COURSE PROPERLY AND IN WITHDRAWAL FROM THE UNIVERSITY

Add the following paragraphs to the University Manual:

- 8.12.12 The Registrar shall issue to the instructor a grade card for every properly registered student in every section. The instructor shall submit to the Registrar on each grade card thus issued a letter grade, an Incomplete, or an S/U if applicable.
- 8.12.13 A student may drop any course without academic penalty before midsemester as designated by the University calendar, and his name will not appear on the final class roster, nor will the course appear in his academic record.
- 8.12.14 In the event that a student has failed to drop a course by midsemester, and fails to attend the class, including any scheduled final examination, for the balance of the semester, the grade for that course shall be recorded as "F"
- 8.12.15 Reporting an Incomplete. (Remains as now worded under 8.12.12)

Change paragraph 8.61.12 of the University Manual as indicated:

Present reading:

8.61.12 If the student withdraws after midsemester, letter grades shall be obtained in writing from each of his instructors showing his standing at the time of withdrawal. If the summary of these grades, had they been received at the end of a semester, would have resulted in academic probation or dismissal, the same action shall be taken as of the date of withdrawal; and the action, together with the reasons for it, shall be noted on the student's record.

Proposed reading:

8.61.12 If the student withdraws from the University after midsemester, a symbol "W" shall be recorded for each course in which the student was registered.
