



FACULTY SENATE

On April 22, 1982, the Faculty Senate approved the following amendment to section 8.20.11 of the University Manual recommended by the University College and General Education Committee in Part II of the UCGE Committee Report #81-82-3:

Students pursuing a second baccalaureate degree shall be exempt from general education requirements for the second degree if in the judgment of their academic dean they have completed comparable requirements for their first degree.
