FACULTY SENATE

On April 21, 1983, the Faculty Senate approved a recommendation from the University College and General Education Committee that ENG 469 The Modern Novel be deleted from the Modern Europe culture cluster in the General Education program.

Rationale: The course which was originally titled the European Novel after 1850 is now primarily a course on the American Novel and no longer appropriate for the Modern Europe culture cluster.
