The University College and General Education Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve the following:

That the 1984-85 Honors Colloquium topic "Real and Artificial Intelligence" be assigned General Education credit as follows:

3 credits in Natural Sciences (N) and/or

3 credits in Social Sciences (S) and/or

3 credits in Letters (L) for a total of 6 credits.
