On January 28, 1988, the Faculty Senate approved the following recommendation in SECTION II of the University College and General Education Report #87-88-2:

That the following courses be assigned into the General Education Program:

ENG 247 Introduction to Pan-African Literature (II,3) into the Fine Arts and Literature (A) area.

ENG 258 Afro-American Literature 1900-Present (II.3) into the Fine Arts and Literature (A) area.

PHL 110 Women and Moral Rights (<u>I or II.3</u>) into the <u>Letters (L) area.</u>
