Program requirements: Thesis option: A thesis based on independent experimental research and 24 credits of course work including PLS 501 and 502. Non-thesis option (with permission of the Department at time of admission): 36 credits of course work with a minimum of 14 credits in Plant Sciences to include PLS 501 and 502 and at least one of the following: PLS 511, PLS 512, PLS 571, PLS 572, or PLS 576. Three credits in experimental statistics and a written project involving significant independent work (PLS 591 or 592) are also required. A written comprehensive examination administered by the student's major professor and two additional members of the faculty (at least one must be from the Plant Sciences Department) is required after most courses have been taken.
