RESEARCH POLICY AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE REPORT #1991-92-1

October 25, 1991

Pursuant to Faculty Senate action of September 26, 1991, REPOFAC, at its meeting of October 25, 1991, reviewed the Policy Statement on Scientific Misconduct and resolved to submit the following report and recommendation:

In view of the uncertainties relating to the federal policies and procedures on Scientific Misconduct and challenges thereto now before the courts; in view of the possibility that the federal agencies may amend these policies and procedures; and in view of the fact that the temporary URI procedures, (promulgated to the University community in December 1989 and now in effect and subject to review by the Faculty Senate) have been reviewed by appropriate groups, the Research Policy and Facilities Committee recommends:

That the Faculty Senate takes no further action on the Policy Statement on Policies and Procedures for Dealing with and Reporting Possible Misconduct in Science until such time as further clarification becomes available from the federal government.
